THE ART OF BATHING *Exhibition*
25 March 2015 to 31 January 2016

Portland's iconic baths, beaches and bathing boxes are celebrated in this exhibition focusing on Portland's seaside past.

From the mid 19th century to the mid 20th century, three public baths have graced the shoreline of Portland Bay.

The first baths were built in 1858 and the second in 1880. The third baths built in 1889 are the most iconic and were a landmark in the bay until their demolition in the 1960s.

The exhibition includes numerous photographs of the public baths, bathing boxes and beach scenes.

Also included are building plans, vintage bathing costumes, and a copy of the original contract specification for the third baths.
